(*) • Produce a series of facts about the route. Length, Countries, Main cities etc. (* or **) • Find out about the environment on the route – weather, landscape plants and animals etc. (**)
Weeks 2 / 3	Planning.	How will you travel and what do you need to take? Getting started: www.bbc.co.uk/news www.google.co.uk	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw a large map (A3 or larger) of the route.(*) Add pictures that you have found about the route (+*) OR Draw your own 'cartoon' map with pictures.
