

New UCAS Tariff – 2017

- The new tariff applies to all university applications as of 2017 regardless of if the qualification is new or old style.
- Anyone applying in 2017 will use the new system regardless of when they did their qualifications. This has implications for any of our current Y13 who are deferring for a year.
- Not all unis will use the tariff, some will still use grade offers
- The new AS level is now worth 40% of the full A-Level to reflect the level of difficulty in the course
- Duke of Edinburgh no longer gets credit on the tariff
- Music and Dance qualifications still do count
- There is a calculator on the internet to use which is really helpful to calculate total points, www.ucas.com/advisors/tariff-2017
